


The Art of Living Frigicoll


Casa Cacao - Chocolate Factory and Hotel by Roca Brothers



A World Heritage site and a base for discovering a thousand years of civilisation, Tarragona is an exceptional enclave thanks to its location, an hour from Barcelona and ten minutes from Reus airport, its climate and its monuments but also thanks to its people, who have preserved its traditions in an unrivalled fashion, all the while working with commitment and dynamism to make their city a first-class destination for professional events. An open Roman city situated on the Mediterranean and more recently a commercial and touristic port, Tarragona has hosted numerous traditional events such as the Castellers or the Tarraco Viva. The city and the surrounding area are well-known for the quality of their natural products. This, together with the land surrounding it – one of the most fertile in Europe – makes the region a significant fruit-growing region, boasting a major food and wine-producing industry. With a high quality of life, Lleida enjoys a significant area of influence and a major service culture which provide a high organisational potential.





BARCELONA PROVINCE

Costa Barcelona is strategically placed with the international airport of Barcelona El Prat at its very heart, Girona airport at the north and Reus at the south, and that is why it has become an ideal destination for business tourism. The port of Barcelona is one of the largest in Europe and the city's excellent infrastructure of highways, roads and railways means central Barcelona is no more than an hour away from any part of the Costa Barcelona. 

PortAventura Convention Centre has expanded its facilities by 6,000 m2 and covers a total surface area of 20,000 m2 with this new addition. The new building, which blends into the surrounding landscape, features a new room, called "Roma", that can be divided into three sections. It covers 2,000 m2 in total and has the capacity to accommodate more than 2,000 people. This new space boasts natural light, a feature shared by all the rooms and common spaces at the Convention Centre.



TRANSPORT







Ryanair operates four new routes all year long: 5 weekly frequencies to Athens (Greece), 2 to Riga (Latvia), 2 to Podgorica (Montenegro) and 2 to Goteborg (Sweden). New route to Alghero (Italy) from Girona.



Air Canada has extended the operating months to Canada during winter season, with 3 weekly frequencies to **Montreal** and 4 weekly frequencies to **Toronto**.



Direct flights between Barcelona and **Reykjavik** (Iceland) with two weekly frequencies, Tuesdays and Saturdays, between May 23 and September 8, 2020.



Volotea will operate its first route from Barcelona this 2020. From April, the company will link Barcelona with **Strasbourg** (France), twice a week.



SkyUp Airlines starts 3 weekly flights to Kiev (Ukraine).



The Barcelona-**Murcia** (Spain) route starts on March 30 and will have three weekly freqüències.
